

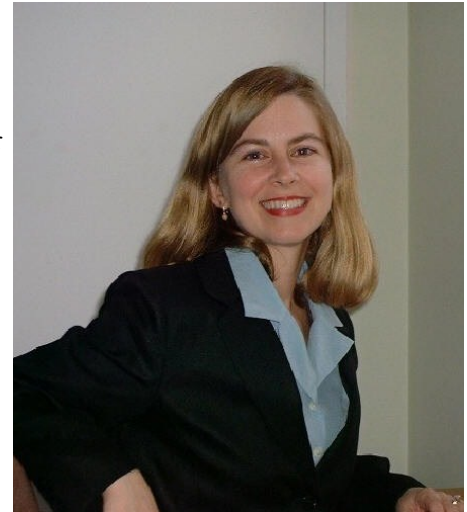

"The Mediterranean Atlantic from a Braudelian Perspective"

Professor Mangan specializes in the history of early Latin America with particular emphasis on the Andean region. She is the author of *Trading Roles: Gender, Ethnicity, and the Urban Economy, Potosí, 1545 - 1700* (Durham: Duke University Press, 2005). *Trading Roles* is a social history of trade in Spain's biggest silver mining town in the New World with special emphasis on the roles of native Andeans and women in the city's economy. In addition, Mangan is the editor of José de Acosta, *Natural and Moral History of the Indies* (Durham: Duke University Press, 2002).
